

### Derby Economic Development Project update report

### August 2024

### **ACTIVE PROJECTS**

### Rehabilitation of Derby Greenway Pedestrian Bridge

Luchs finished and submitted the review of the Preliminary Design prepared by ATANE for the repair of the Greenway pedestrian bridge over the Housatonic Railroad tracks. We are awaiting feedback from ATANE on the next steps which is likely to call for a draft RFP for the repairs

### **Site reuse of Main Street South**

- We have had on-going discussions with Rubino Bros regarding a prospective Derby industrial site for the relocation of the Metal Recycling Center.
- We have continued discussions with a NJ-based property developer who
  has expressed active interest in working with the City on the site reuse

### **Trolley Pointe (90 Main Street) & Cedar Village (67-71 Minerva St)**

Cedar Village (67-71 Minerva St) which should be open to residents in October 2024, has 90 units, 39 studios and 51 one bedroom units and 102 parking spaces with 10% ( 9 units) below market rate

Trolley Pointe, 90 Main Street, which should be open to residents in December 2024 has 105 units, 62 studios, 39 1 bedroom units and 4 2 bedroom units Under an agreement with the CT Commissioner of Housing, 27 units (26%) will receive a State subsidy to provide for workforce housing, (below market rate) the balance will be at market rate which has not been announced at this time



### Expansion of Derby Landfill (1.5MW-4.0 MW) ground based Solar System

- BQ ENERGY, who are the leading North American installers of Solar systems on landfills and brownfield sites, have provided data on the net energy credits (\$45,000) generated in 2023 by the existing (550KW) Derby landfill solar installation.
- BQEnergy were unable to present proposals for the expansion of the Derby landfill, at no cost to the City, with further solar panels (1.5MW-4MW) with battery energy storage systems, at the July 25th Property & Development subcommittee meeting, as it was cancelled.
- Unless a Special meeting is convened to invite BQ Energy to return, we will miss the 2024 bid window for installation in 2025 which will set back our potential to increase revenues by \$50,000-\$100,000 per year from the landfill, until 2026.

### Other energy related opportunities

- Derby participates in the UI SCEF (Shared Clean Energy Facility) program. The 2.8 MW Derby fuel cell at Coon Hollow Road is providing Derby customers with a 2.5% discount (\$0.25 per kwh) on their Electricity Bills
- Griffin Hospital is benefiting from this system along with multiple (802) Derby customers

### **Derby's Fountain Lake Industrial Park**

We are exploring with XLI, a Rochester NY based precision metal manufacturer, a potential design & build of a 50,000 SF manufacturing facility that would create around 150 new high skill jobs in Derby. We have met with Ansonia in July to explore an equitable solution for road and sewer access. Grant Funding is available.

### **Block Family Trust land**

We had further discussions with the owner, Architects and Lawyers representing the Block Family Trust in July. Their preliminary plans include:

240 apartments

27 Single Family Homes

20 Condominiums

16 Duplexes/town houses

8 Triplexes/town houses

In addition, the plans identify 32,600 SF of commercial space including:

### 33 Elizabeth Street redevelopment

### <u>Article from Valley Sentinel</u>

"The board unanimously approved a tax break that will help a downtown property owner convert an old office building into 32 apartments. The first floor will remain commercial.

Owner Joseph Voll received approvals for the conversion of 33 Elizabeth St. from the Derby Planning & Zoning Commission back in 2021.

However, the project has been on hold as Voll waited for the economy to approve, according to a tax abatement request submitted to the Alders.

The conversion will cost \$3.6 million and add millions to the property's assessment, and therefore bolster Derby's tax rolls, according to the submitted paperwork.

The Alders approved a five-year tax abatement plan that discounts taxes 50 percent the first year, 40 percent in year two, 30 percent in year three, 20 percent in year four, and 20 percent in year five. The discounts would stop in year six.

The paperwork points out that Derby will still be receiving more in taxes from the property with the abatement plan than it is receiving right now. The property is assessed at just \$382,270, but the property owner estimates that number to increase to around \$4 million when the project is complete.

Construction could start in August".

We are working with CJ Fucci, WCBA and RWA to upgrade the water and sewer pipelines into 33 Elizabeth St ahead of repaving Minerva St.

### OSHA:

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration has enforced Safety and Health practices of fire departments in accordance with their "Fire Brigades" Standard first put in effect in 1980. Modern fire departments have progressed well beyond the parameters in all aspects of the service including personal protective equipment, apparatus, fire station construction, fitness testing and many other tasks.

The National Fire Protection Agency (NFPA) maintains current standards relative to all aspects of fire fighting, but without enforcement authorization. OSHA has proposed (February 2024) to adopt the NFPA standards as a Rule to replace their outdated "Fire Brigade" standard. The public comment period for the OSHA proposed change ended on July 22, 2024. A hearing with virtual participation is scheduled for the fall for stakeholders to provide input. We the Chiefs and Commissioner will participate in the hearing along with representatives of multiple professional organizations to which we belong.

To summarize the Rule Change proposal will have a direct effect on every fire department in the country including Derby. The final draft is expected to be released in early 2025 with adoption to be determined.

### Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):

The Department submitted a grant application for \$334.426.34 with a local match of \$16,721.32 to replace 26 of the 68 SCBA has in our inventory. FEMA has initiated grant awards for the current cycle and will continue each week to September 30.

Nearly all of the new sets of turnout gear purchased with authorized Aarp funds have been received and issued to the qualified members. To date, the gear is performing as expected in several fire incidents.

### Facilities:

The department has secured a vendor to supply and install extractor gear washers at each of the firehouses. Aarp funding has been authorized and is earmarked to complete this project.

A sanitary sewer backup occurred within Hotchkiss Hose Co #1. The contractor is progressing with repairs and renovations and will complete before the end of August. All work relative to this project has been funded with insurance claim payments.

### Operations:

Please reference the Case & Time reports included with this narrative.

The department regularly responds into Ansonia, as Ansonia responds to Derby. Although mutual aid responses have also occurred with Shelton, Seymour, Orange and Oxford for many decades, in recent years, the Ansonia and Derby Fire Departments have moved forward with planned dispatches for response. Historically, "Mutual Aid" responses between municipalities occur for extraordinary incidents requiring additional resources, relief of members, additional water supply, etc. Ansonia and Derby have moved up to auto dispatch specific resources across Division Street on initial or subsequent dispatches to incidents with certain confirmed conditions identified at the location. "Smoke in the Building", Flames "pushing through the roof", or "victims trapped" are some examples. The practice has worked extremely well and has benefited both communities in mitigating very dangerous conditions in a very quick manner.

The Derby Fire Department is thankful to all of our Mutual Aid Departments for their assistance over the years and we remain committed to providing the same.

The following is a report on the activities of the Fire Marshal's Office for the Month of July 2024.

### **OFFICE TIME:**

The following hours include the time the staff (Deputy Fire Marshal & Inspector) put in at the office for staff meetings, training, investigations, writing reports, etc. The total for this month is 112 hours. Fire Marshal's time is 40-hours a week, split between office hours and field work. The month of July tends to see more office hours due to scheduling around summer vacation of tenants, landlords, and personnel.

### **PLAN REVIEWS:**

The Fire Marshal's office only received 1 plan review for this month. This was for the conversion of the Italian Pavilion into a cannabis shop.

### **PROPERTY INSPECTIONS:**

There were 18 properties in various stages of the code compliance process. These include commercial and multifamily housing inspections and reinspection. In addition to sprinkler systems, fire alarm testing, and cooking hoods and suppression systems testing. Property inspection continue to be scheduled in advance. We have completed our cycle of multifamily housing inspections in 2023. We were able to complete all 254 registered properties. These occupancies are required to be inspected annually. After years of falling behind, we are now at the point of repeating the cycle in a timely manner. In addition, we are now focusing on other occupancy types that have not been inspected for several years. These are typically businesses, manufacturing and store and warehouses. They also cover gas stations and fuel pumps. These occupancies run on a 2–4-year inspection cycle. However, we find that we are well beyond those timelines.

### Fire Investigations:

The month of July did not have any fires of significance that required a fire marshal response.

### **Summary:**

As reported last month, our new system of contacting multifamily landlords and owners has been working out very well. Streamlining our process by calling owners directly has enabled us to schedule inspections through the month of August. This has freed our office to focus on performing inspections and limiting waiting times for mailing responses. In addition, records are being converted from index cards to excel spread sheets. This leads to better documentation. We will continue to have our deputy fire marshal focus on overdue commercial inspections. Our fire inspector and I will continue to focus on multifamily housing. Finally, our office is still down one fire inspector. We have an individual who is qualified and willing to join our department. We are currently waiting on the BOA or the safety subcommittee to approve this position that has been budgeted for and approved.

### Monthly Report

July 2024

The following activities occurred during the month of July:

- Emergency plans were obtained from the PD, FD, and EMS for the fireworks. All of the plans were compiled and integrated as part of a citywide action plan for the event. Street closures and other event information was entered into the DEMHS WEBEOC online tool to aid first responders in the event of a large-scale emergency.
- FirstLight,, the operator of the Stevenson Dam, sent out their current emergency notification contact information for the city. The information was sent to all of the city's emergency services and the mayor's office in order for them to update their or confirm the accuracy of the information. When completed, the information will be returned to FirstLight.
- The emergency management director attended the regional DEMHS monthly meeting.
- A possible grant for EOC upgrades is being reviewed. There is a May 15th submission date to the state for the grant.
- A portable generator was deployed at the Hotchkiss Hose firehouse due to a power outage. The building does not have an operating generator to power radio equipment for Derby PD, FD, OEM, and EMS which are located in the building. The equipment can only operate approximately 15 minutes while on battery backup. Shelton PD, Orange PD, and Orange FD also have radio equipment at the location.
- OEM also responded to the fire alarm building on Cottage St to confirm that it regained power after the outage. The building is also without a functional generator and the PD, DPW, and FD/EMS have radio equipment requiring backup power due to limited operating time of the backup batteries.
- A request was made to the regional DEMHS office for a districts traffic control trailer. The request was granted and the trailer was obtained to aid with street closures during the Storm Ambulance 5k road race. The trailer was returned to Hamden the day after the race.

## **Board of Alderman Report August 2024 Water Pollution Control Authority**

**Plant** – The plant is operating within permit limits. The new plant blower installed and is running without issues.

**Plant Upgrade** – In 2014 the City passed a \$31.42 million dollar referendum to replace three of the City's pump stations and begin plant upgrades. As of November 2022, approximately \$15 million dollars have been used on replacing the three pump stations and sewer main replacement in the RT-34 project. With approximately \$16.4 million dollars remaining the focus has turned on a full facilities upgrade (under DEEP order) with a cost estimated at \$60 million dollars.

Collections System – Completed 4,500ft of sewer cleaning and 1,400ft of CCTV.

**Pump Station** – All four pump stations are operating without issue.
