June 2024

ACTIVE PROJECTS

Rehabilitation of Derby Greenway Pedestrian Bridge

• ATANE, the designer confirmed to the city that their design review of the status of the Bridge has been completed and Luchs Engineering Consultants are reviewing their design review and will advise the city of the findings.

Site reuse of Main Street South

- We have had positive discussions with Rubinos Bros regarding a prospective Derby industrial site for the relocation of the metal processing Center.
- Barretta Enterprises are seeking City help to find a new location for their landscaping business in Derby.
- We met with a NJ-based property developer who has expressed active interest in working with the City on the site reuse.

Trolley Pointe Development (90 Main Street)

- Exterior construction largely complete, 105 apartments, 27 will be offered as workforce housing, subsidized by CT Dept. of Housing - mix one- and two-bedroom units.
- International Trade Center elected to locate to Providence RI
- Occupancy expected December 2024.

Cedar Village (67-71 Minerva Street) redevelopment

 Exterior construction mostly completed of 95 apartments with 10% Affordable Housing. Occupancy expected in October 2024.
 Cedar Village & Brennan Developers developing preliminary plans for condo housing project on Summit Hill in Derby which will minimize removal of rock. Discussed with P&7

Derby Parking Garage - stabilization and restoration

• The City of Derby requested \$10,000,000 of CDS funds to hire a state qualified vendor to complete essential safety repairs and restoration to its 49-year-old 4-floor 300-space municipal public parking garage. The scope of this project involves partial and full-depth concrete repairs, roof construction, structural steel repairs, waterproofing, painting, plumbing/drainage enhancements, stairs improvements, elevator safety updates, adding EV stations, engineering, and contingency.

Expansion of Derby Landfill (1.5MW-4.0 MW) ground based Solar System

 We met with the President of BQ ENERGY, who are the leading North American installers of Solar systems on landfills and brownfield sites. They offered to analyze and report on the savings generated by the existing Derby landfill solar installation. We discussed some options for expansion, including solar panels (4MW) with battery energy storage systems and they will propose to Derby a renewable energy package for review by the Property & Development subcommittee in June.

Other active developments include:

Derby's Fountain Lake Industrial Park

• XLI, a Rochester NY based precision metal manufacturer, met with the City and we are exploring, with other parties, a potential design & build of a 50,000 SF manufacturing facility that would create around 150 new high skill jobs in Derby. We have received a revised cost estimate (\$2.5M) for a single road expansion into the Area and sewer connection costs to Ansonia. Grant Funding is available, and we are in conversation with another Precision plastics manufacturer interested in a 100,000 SF facility.

Block Family Trust land

 We are having further discussions with the owner, Architects and Lawyers representing the Block Family Trust in early June. Their preliminary plans include apartments and single-family homes together with some convenient services and 14 acres of public open space on their 70 acre land parcel in Derby.

33 Elizabeth Street redevelopment

 We received an application for the prevailing City of Derby tax incentive program for improvements of 33 Elizabeth Street, a project pre-approved for 32 apartments and first floor retail space, which could provide 40-50 new jobs. A presentation will be made to the BOAA in June. The time frame will take approximately 24-30 months from planned start in August 2024 to finish.

CT Custom Woodworking

 Completed the acquisition of the property on 247 Roosevelt Drive of The Weimann Bros Mfg Co and are relocating their business from Milford to Derby. They are sub leasing some of the 12,000 SF to Weimann Bros who will continue to operate their tool & die company and will retain their current employees.

2000 Rossenbauer Fire Pump - 24 years in service

This apparatus was taken out of service to complete necessary repairs and maintenance for the latter part of May. It was returned to service while awaiting parts to complete a long list of needed repairs. Work is anticipated to resume by mid June and will continue into July.

Mutual aid apparatus will be dispatched to cover response tasks typically performed with crews on this apparatus.

Engine 11 - Storm Engine Company 1996 Pierce

Engine 12 – Storm Engine Company 2017 Pierce

Engine 13 - East End Hose Company 2000 HME

Engine 14 - Hotchkiss Hose Company 2009 Rosenbauer

Truck 15 - Paugassett H & L Company 2004 Pierce

Personal Protective Equip ment (PPE):

The Department submitted a grant application for \$334.426.34 with a Local match of \$16,721.32 to replace 26 of the 68 SCBA has is our inventory. We expect notification from FEMA- U.S. Fire Administration soon.

Nearly all of the new sets of turnout gear purchased with authorized Aarp funds have been received and issued to the qualified members. To date, the gear is performing as expected in several fire incidents.

Facilities:

The department is working to complete purchases of the extractor gear washers and dryers for each of the firehouses. Aarp funding has been authorized and is earmarked to complete this project.

A sanitary sewer backup occurred within Hotchkiss Hose Co #1. The backup impacted parts of the kitchen and recreation room. The backup has been mitigated and preliminary cleanup completed. The Volunteer Firefighters Insurance policy provides coverage for such an event. The following is a report on the activities of the Fire Marshal's Office for the Month of May 2024.

OFFICE TIME:

The following hours include the time the staff (Deputy Fire Marshal & Inspector) put in at the office for staff meetings, training, investigations, writing reports, etc. The total for this month is 72 hours. Fire Marshal's time is 35-hour s a week, split between office hours and field work. This month was the annual New England Fire Investigation Seminar held between May 20-24, Saint Anselm College, Manchester New Hampshire. The course provides 40 hours of fire marshal credits to our inspectors towards maintaining their required continuing educational credits for fire marshal certification. Our Deputy Fire Marshal attended this year's program. 20 of the 40 hours attended comes off his weekly accrued time, while the other 20 is attended on his own personal time. Our Fire Inspector did not attend this year's event. However, she submitted 12 hours of office time.

PLAN REVIEWS:

The Fire Marshal's office reviewed 2 plans submitted for building renovations. New construction submittals have been limited. However, building renovations continue to be our largest sector for plan reviews.

PROPERTY INSPECTIONS:

There were 20 properties in various stages of the code compliance process. These include commercial and multifamily housing inspections and reinspection. In addition to sprinkler systems, fire alarm testing, and cooking hoods and suppression systems testing. Property inspection continue to be scheduled in advance.

Fire Investigations:

The month of May only saw 1 fire that needed a fire marshal investigation. This was a motorcycle fire caused by the charging of a lithium-ion battery.

Summary:

As reported last month, our new system of contacting multifamily landlords and owners has been working out very well. Streamlining our process by calling owners directly has enabled us to schedule inspections through the month of July. This has freed our office to focus on performing inspections and limited waiting times for mailing responses. We will continue to have our deputy fire marshal focus on overdue commercial inspections. Our fire inspector and I will continue to focus on multifamily housing. Finally, our office is still down one fire inspector. We have an individual who is qualified and willing to join our department. We are currently waiting on the BOA to approve this position that has been budgeted for and approved.

The Director attended the monthly regional DEMHS meeting and the quarterly regional planning meeting.

A request was made to the state for a traffic control trailer to be used in July. Traffic cones and barricades will be utilized duty the Storm Ambulance 75th anniversary 5k road race.

Deputy Director Lenart was approved by the state to teach mandatory upper level NIMS courses. Tho will allow Derby to sponsor classes. Having an in-house instructor should reduce travel and class fees for our first responders and city officials who are required to attend this training.

The director began working on a project to improve radio communications at Griffin Hospital for fire and EMS personnel. In January, an incident at the hospital occurred and the responding personnel encountered serious communication issues. Equipment to build a small transportable repeats bro gained. Once the device is assembled, testing coverage inside the hospital will be conducted.

Emergency Management is reviewing the emergency response plans fro large scale events. The next event to be reviewed will be the fireworks. The PD,FD, and EMS will provide plans for their departments and emergency management will collaborate with them to produce a single plan for all of the emergency services. This information is shared with DEMHS.

The EOC (emergency operations center) relocation project continues to be worked on. Potential locations are being investigated for use of the EOC at city hall is unavailable or requires evacuation.

Board of Alderman Report June 2024 Water Pollution Control Authority

Plant – The plant is operating within permit limits.

Plant Upgrade – In 2014 the City passed a \$31.42 million dollar referendum to replace three of the City's pump stations and begin plant upgrades. As of November 2022, approximately \$15 million dollars have been used on replacing the three pump stations and sewer main replacement in the RT-34 project. With approximately \$16.4 million dollars remaining the focus has turned on a full facilities upgrade (under DEEP order) with a cost estimated at \$60 million dollars.

Collections System – Completed 4,700 liner feet of sewer main cleaning & 8,600 liner feet CCTV

Pump Station – All four pump stations are operating without issue.
