"Cupcake Decorating with Kim"

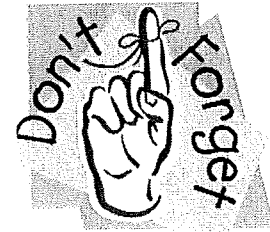
